



2165 - SPECIFICATION FOR REMOVAL OF CONCRETE CURBS, SIDEWALKS, AND DRIVEWAYS

2165 - 1 DESCRIPTION

1.01 The work shall consist of the removal and disposal, in whole, or in part, of concrete curbs, curb and gutter, sidewalks, and driveways shown on the plans or designated by the Engineer.

2165 - 2 MATERIALS

2165 - 3 CONSTRUCTION

3.01 If a section of sidewalk or curb is to be removed it shall be separated from, and without damage to, the section that is to remain. No explosives shall be used.

3.02 The section of curb, curb and gutter, sidewalk, and driveway to be removed shall be staked by the Engineer.

3.03 Debris may be disposed of as follows:

- (a) If earth embankments are to be constructed as part of the contract, the debris may be used in the embankments in accordance with the requirements for Embankments (Specification 2300).
- (b) The debris may be disposed of in disposal pits. The Engineer will determine if material excavated from disposal pits is acceptable for use in the construction of embankments. Surplus material from disposal pits shall be disposed of as directed by the Engineer. A minimum of thirty (30) centimetres of earth is required over the buried debris. The ground surface shall be restored and levelled.
- (c) The debris may be hauled to a disposal site selected by the Contractor. The use of the site and the method of disposal will be subject to the approval of the Engineer.

2165 - 4 MEASUREMENT

4.01 Concrete sidewalks and driveways will be measured in square metres. The actual surface area will be measured.

4.02 Concrete curbs and curb and gutter will be measured in metres along the front face of the curb.

2165 - 5 PAYMENT

- 5.01 Payment for REMOVAL OF CONCRETE SIDEWALKS AND DRIVEWAYS will be at the contract unit price per square metre. The unit price will be full compensation for cutting, demolishing, loading, hauling, dumping, and disposing of the concrete sidewalks and driveways, and restoring and levelling the ground surface over the buried debris.
- 5.02 Payment for REMOVAL OF CONCRETE CURBS will be at the contract unit price per metre. The unit price will be full compensation for cutting, demolishing, loading, hauling, dumping, and disposing of the concrete curbs and curb and gutter, and restoring and levelling the ground surface over the buried debris.
- 5.03 If material excavated from disposal pits is used in the construction of embankments, the excavation will be paid for in accordance with the requirements for Earth Excavation (Specification 2200) and/or Rock Excavation (Specification 2250) and/or Disposal of Surplus Rock (Specification 2320).
- 5.04 If material excavated from disposal pits is not used in the construction of embankments, the excavation will not be paid for directly but will be considered as a subsidiary obligation of the Contractor under other contract items.
